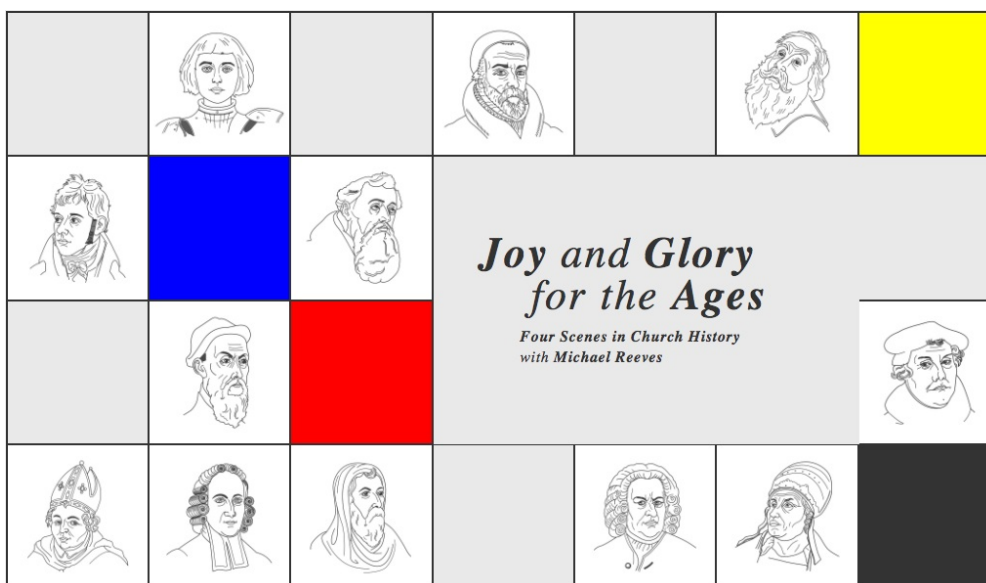


Joy and Glory for the Ages
